"God plans and controls everything that happens, without being responsible for s and evil, and without removing human responsibility." Not just sovereign – also loving. G . So his sovereignty is good. God has a purpose. Providence = "Purposeful sovereignty." "God sees to it." Creating and sustaining > Psalm 104 > Jesus, God the S , sustains the universe (Colossians 1:17, Hebrews 1:3). Laws of science – God's habits. > Weather and animals and birds (Matthew 5:45, 6:26) > Purpose: God's glory - Psalm 104:31 Ruling Over the nations / world events > Habakkuk 1:5-6, 2:6-19, 2:20. Isaiah 13-27. Daniel 4:34-35. > Why? For his glory and the good of his people. Eg Exodus 9:16, 14:4, Ezekiel 36:22. > "The theatre of God's glory." (John Calvin). Over the circumstances of our lives > Life of Joseph (Genesis 37-50, particularly 50:19-21). > Hairs of our head numbered (Matthew 10:28-31). See also Proverbs 16:9; Psalm 139, particularly v16.
